# Tennessee Healthy Hardwoods Field Days



The same program will be offered at all locations. When registering, indicate the location you will be attending:

**April 12 - Ames Plantation**  
Fayette/Hardeman Co. (Grand Junction)  
3890 Buford Ellington Rd.

10.5 miles South of Bolivar on Rt. 18, turn right onto Ames Road. Follow 4.5 miles to T turn left. Follow 1 1/2 miles, then jog right, then left (at log cabins). Bryan Hall is .2 miles on left.

**April 13 - University of the South**  
Franklin County (Sewanee)

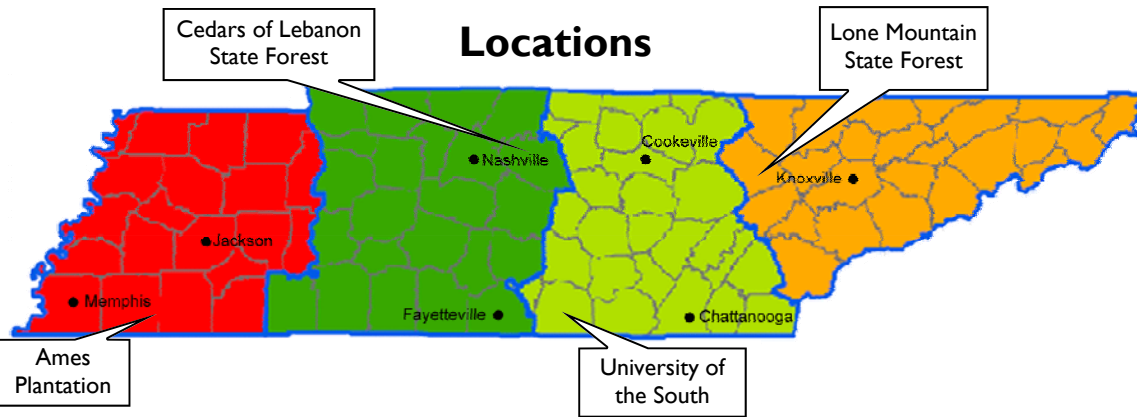
From I-24, at exit 134, go west on 41A approx. 5.1 miles, and turn right at 2nd set of flashing lights (University Ave.) Go 1 mile to Texas Ave. Turn left on Texas, go past the football field, and veer right onto Breakfield Rd. Go approx. 800 ft to Crosby Ln., turn left, and follow signs to the site.

**April 19 - Cedars of Lebanon State Forest**  
Wilson County (Lebanon)

From I-40 and Rt 231 at Lebanon, follow South ~ 6.5 miles to Cedars State Park. Turn left and follow ~ 1 1/2 miles. At "Y" veer right and go short distance to the lodge on the right.

**April 20 - Lone Mountain State Forest**  
Morgan County (Wartburg)

From I-40 at Harriman exit, travel north on Rt. 27 approximately 15.5 miles to small gas station. Turn left (west) at the Lone Mt. State Forest sign. Follow 1/2 mile to the State Forest Shop on right.
