### **ENVIRONMENT**

Forests are a critical part of our environment, protecting rivers and streams, stabilizing soil, and habitat for wildlife, forming a vital piece of our state's natural beauty. Forests cover 52%, or 14.4 million acres, of Tennessee land.



### **ECONOMICS**

In 2021, the forest and forest product industry contributed \$21.7 billion to the Tennessee economy and \$500 million in state and local tax revenue, with 85,500 industry employees working throughout the state,
